Here are some of my favorite fun products from the 2025 Show -- enjoy!

1) High-tech cat perch

As the owner of a cat who does not like to be handled (except on her own terms), I am intrigued by this multi-purpose cat perch. The [LG AeroCatTower](#) is a cat bed that sits on top of an air purifier, plus it tracks the cat's weight and sleep time!



2) Smart plant planter

No more guessing about whether you are killing your house plants! [LeafyPod's smart planter](#) uses AI to adjust water intake from a reservoir and even makes recommendations about sunlight exposure.

3) The cutest solar car

This adorable dolphin-shaped electric car lets you drive up to 40 miles a day on sunshine power! For longer trips, you can plug in the [Aptera solar vehicle](#) and get up to 400 miles from a full charge.



4) Art gallery digital clock

[Klydoclock's](#) digital display comes with a regularly updated library of digital works and animations by independent artists from around the world. The free lifetime subscription currently has thousands of pieces.

5) Spoon that seasons like salt – without salt

Kirin Holdings' [Electric Salt Spoon](#) zaps food to make it taste saltier —very useful for those of us who must cut back on their salt intake. “A weak electric current is passed from the tip of the spoon to the food to enhance the taste of the meal, including salty and umami taste.”

If money is no object, you need to check out Bodyfriend's \$20,000 [733 Massage Chair](#).
